NOTICE OF RACE

(This Notice of Race may be amended from time to time pursuant to RRS 89.2b)

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2. The US Prescriptions to RRS 60.3, 67, 70.5(a), 76.1, 61.4 and Appendix R shall apply.
- 1.3. In all Optimist classes RRS 61 will be changed as follows: The red protest flag required in Rule 61.1(a) shall be attached to the lifejacket in a manner that conceals it until displayed. Further changes to Rule 61.1 may be part of the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.4. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.5. Competitors shall wear a properly secured personal flotation device at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing clothes.
- 1.6. Appendix P will be in effect and may be modified by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.7. Class rules regarding qualifying events and championships will not apply
- 1.8. In accordance with RRS G3, a boat chartered or loaned for this event may carry national letters or a sail number in contravention of her class rules.

2. ADVERTISING AND BOAT IDENTIFICATION

Boats may be required to display additional identification numbers on their sail or bow. Boats may also be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1. The regatta is open to competitors 18 years of age or younger on December 26, 2022 who declare they are members of US Sailing, or their national authority, and their respective class association.





3.2. The regatta is open to all boats conforming to class rules of the Club 420, ILCA 7, ILCA 6, ILCA 4 and Optimist classes with a maximum number of boats in each class as follows:

ILCA 4	50
ILCA 6 & 7 (Combined)	125
Optimist RWB	240
Optimist Green	70

If the ILCA 4 division is registered at full capacity, competitors who are registered for other ILCA classes may not change their registration to ILCA 4.

3.3. Optimist age groups are based on their age on December 26, 2022:

White - Ten (10) years old or younger

Blue - Eleven (11) or twelve (12) years old

Red - Thirteen (13) to fifteen (15) years old

Green – Novice sailors of any age who have not previously competed in RWB events

3.4. Registration will open as follows:

- 3.5. Online registration will close December 10, 2022, 24:00 EST. Additional entries will be at the sole discretion of the Organizing Authority.
- 3.6. Registration is not complete until payment has been made and the Sailor Waiver has been executed online. A waitlist will be created when a class has reached the maximum number of entries. If and when a spot opens, the next entry on the waitlist will be registered and payment will be required to complete the registration.
- 3.7. Sailors who have not completed the Sailor Waiver by December 13, 2022 will not be registered and will forfeit their registration and their fee.





4. FEES

- 4.1. A refund, less a \$150 processing fee, will be granted to those entries canceled by 18:00 hrs on November 13, 2022. All other refunds will be at the sole discretion of the OA.
- 4.2. Coach and Spectator Boats -- All coach and spectator boats must register on the <u>regatta website</u> and check-in with the organizing authority on-site at Coral Reef Yacht Club between December 21 and December 26 and provide the names of competitors they support to receive a support boat flag. A non-refundable credit card fee of \$1 per coach or spectator boat will be charged at the time of registration and the card will remain on file. If the issued ID flag is not returned at the end of the regatta, the card on file will be charged \$75. In addition, each boat must carry a VHF radio, monitoring the channel provided for each of their sailors' course at all times while on the water.
- 4.3. All fees are USD. All fees include state and local taxes. All times and dates are EST.

5. CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

All classes may be divided into two or more divisions at the discretion of the OA.

6. VENUE

The location of the regatta will be on Biscayne Bay. Racing locations for each class will be specified in the Sailing Instructions.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be published on the <u>regatta website</u> prior to the regatta.

10. CHARTERS

Club 420, ILCA and Optimist charters are to be obtained from Orange Bowl International Youth Regatta approved charter companies only. Please refer to the <u>regatta website</u> for charter boat information.

11. SCORING

- 11.1. Twelve (12) races are scheduled for Opti RWB, all ILCA fleets and C420s. Total races for Opti Green will be at the discretion of the Principal Race Officer.
- 11.2. A boat's worst score will be excluded with the completion of five (5) or more races.
